
BTRA SCIENTIST RECEIVES INNOVATION AWARD

Under the aegis of DST-Lockheed Martin India Innovation Growth Programme 2015, run by Department of Science and Technology (DST), Government of India, Lockheed Martin Corporation, USA, Indo-US Science and Technology Forum (USSTF), Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI), Stanford Graduate School of Business, USA and IC²Institute of University of Texas, USA, Scientist Ms. Smita Deogaonkar from The Bombay Textile Research Association (BTRA) is awarded for her innovative work on **'Fabric based Heat Elements for Warmth / Fomentation in Medical Applications'** for the year 2015.
